## Residential Commingled Recycling Items:

**[Rinse all food and drink from containers before recycling!]**

- METAL CANS:** Aluminum, Steel, Tin, and Bi-Metal - rinse, flatten if desired
- GLASS BOTTLES & JARS:** Clear, Brown, Green - rinse, discard lids and rings
- PLASTIC BOTTLES & JUGS:** #1 (PETE) & #2 (HDPE) - rinse, discard lids
- NEWSPAPERS & GLOSSY INSERTS (No Magazines or Telephone Books)**

Glass, Plastics and Cans may all be placed in the same container for collection.

Newsprint must be bundled or put in a Paper Bag and placed beside recycling bin.

Newsprint CANNOT be placed in plastic bags or boxes.
