**ORDINANCE NO. 554**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CALIFORNIA, WASHINGTON COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 525 TO REVISE ARTICLE II "ESTABLISHMENT OF PARKING ZONES" TO ADD THE WEST SIDE OF GREEN STREET FROM SECOND STREET TO THIRD STREET AS A "BUSINESS DISTRICT ZONE;" TO REMOVE THE WEST SIDE OF GREEN STREET FROM SECOND STREET TO THIRD STREET AS A "NON-BUSINESS DISTRICT ZONE;" TO REVISE ARTICLE V "PARKING METER RATES" TO INCREASE THE PARKING METER RATES IN THE BUSINESS DISTRICT ZONES TO TWENTY-FIVE CENTS (25¢) FOR TWENTY (20) MINUTES; TO ADD NEW SECTION VI "RESTRICTED PARKING" THAT WILL PROHIBIT PARKING BETWEEN 3:00 A.M. AND 7:00 A.M. ON CERTAIN STREETS; TO RENUMBER THE REMAINING SECTIONS OF THE ORDINANCE ACCORDINGLY DUE TO THE ADDITION OF NEW ARTICLE VI "RESTRICTED PARKING;" REPEALING INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES AND/OR PORTIONS OF INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES; INCLUDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, Borough Council is authorized to regulate traffic and parking in the Borough of California; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council has determined it to be in the best interest and public welfare of its citizens, visitors and invitees to regulate traffic and parking within the Borough of California; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council previously passed Ordinance No. 525, which repealed prior Ordinance No. 448 and any other inconsistent Borough Ordinances or portions thereof, because Council determined it to be in the best interest and general welfare of the citizens, invitees and visitors of the Borough to revise the existing parking zones, parking meter rates, parking time limits, and fines and penalties for violations thereof;

WHEREAS, Borough Council has determined it to be in the best interest and welfare of the citizens, invitees, and visitors of the Borough to amend Ordinance No. 525 to revise further the existing parking zones, parking meter rates, parking time limits, and, further, to include certain restricted parking zones within the Borough.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED and ENACTED and it is hereby ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of California, Washington County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 525 - ARTICLE II:  
"ESTABLISHMENT OF PARKING ZONES."**

The following amendments will be made to Article II of Ordinance No. 525 by this instant ordinance:

(1) The following area within the Borough shall be added and designated as a "Business District Zone" in Article II of Ordinance No. 525:

<u>ROADWAY</u>	<u>SIDE</u>	<u>BETWEEN</u>
Green Street	West	Second Street to Third Street

(2) The same area within the Borough will be removed from its designation as a "Non-Business District Zone" in Article II of Ordinance No. 525:

<u>ROADWAY</u>	<u>SIDE</u>	<u>BETWEEN</u>
Green Street	West	Second Street to Third Street

**SECTION 2. AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 525 - ARTICLE V: "PARKING METER RATES."**

The following amendment will be made to Article V of Ordinance No. 525 by this instant ordinance:

(1) Business District Zones.

The parking meter rate within the Business District Zones shall be twenty five cents (25¢) for twenty (20) minutes.

**SECTION 3. AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 525 - ADDITION OF NEW ARTICLE VI: "RESTRICTED PARKING."**

This instant ordinance will create the following new section to Ordinance No. 525, which shall become Article VI: "Restricted Parking:"

There shall be no parking between 3:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. on the either side of the following streets:

1. Third Street from Mechanic Street to East Alley;
2. Wood Street between Third Street and First Street;
3. Second Street from Mechanic Street to Beazel Street, and

4. Green Street between Second Street and Third Street.

**SECTION 4. AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 525 – RENUMBERING OF REMAINING ARTICLE NUMBERS.**

As a result of the addition to Ordinance No. 525 of new Article VI “Restricted Parking,” the following Articles of Ordinance No. 525 shall be renumbered as follows:

1. Article VI “Fines and Penalties” shall now become Article VII;
2. Article VII “Severability” shall now become Article VIII;
3. Article VIII “Savings Clause” shall now become Article IX;
4. Article IX “Inconsistencies Repealed” shall now become Article X, and
5. Article X “Effective Date” shall now become Article XI.

**SECTION 5. REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCES.**

Any and all prior Ordinances and/or any and all portions of prior Ordinances, including, specifically, Ordinance No. 525, which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict. The remaining Ordinances and/or portions of prior Ordinances, not modified herein, shall remain the same.

**SECTION 6. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**

Should any section, provision or other part of this Ordinance be found to be illegal, unenforceable or void, such shall not affect the remainder hereof, which shall remain fully binding, valid and enforceable, and such section, provision or other part shall be modified to the extent necessary to so conform to the law.

The Borough Council of the Borough of California hereby declares its intention that should any section, provision or other part of this Ordinance be found to be illegal, unenforceable or void, it would have made the foregoing Ordinance without such part or with such part so modified so as to conform to the law.

**SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.
