**ORDINANCE NO. 556**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CALIFORNIA, WASHINGTON COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 554, WHICH AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 525, TO REVISE ARTICLE VI "RESTRICTED PARKING" TO DELETE PROVISION NO. 4 THAT PROVIDED THAT THERE SHALL BE NO PARKING BETWEEN 3:00 A.M. AND 7:00 A.M. ON EITHER SIDE OF GREEN STREET BETWEEN SECOND AND THIRD STREET; REPEALING INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES AND/OR PORTIONS OF INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES; INCLUDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, Borough Council is authorized to regulate traffic and parking in the Borough of California; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council has determined it to be in the best interest and public welfare of its citizens, visitors and invitees to regulate traffic and parking within the Borough of California; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council previously passed Ordinance No. 525, which repealed prior Ordinance No. 448 and any other inconsistent Borough Ordinances, because Council determined it to be in the best interest and general welfare of the citizens, invitees and visitors of the Borough to revise the existing parking zones, parking meter rates, parking time limits and fines and penalties for violations thereof;

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2016, Borough Council adopted Ordinance No. 554, which amended Ordinance No. 525, to revise the existing parking zones, parking meter rates, parking time limits, and, further, to include certain restricted parking zones within the Borough as Borough Council had determined it to be in the best interest and welfare of the citizens, invitees, and visitors of the Borough.

WHEREAS, Borough Council has determined it to be in the best interest and welfare of the citizens, invitees, and visitors of the Borough to amend Ordinance No. 554 and again amend Ordinance No. 525 to remove one of the restricted parking zones within the Borough that was created by the adoption of Ordinance No. 554.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED and ENACTED and it is hereby ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of California, Washington County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 554 AND ORDINANCE NO. 525 –  
REMOVAL OF RESTRICTED PARKING ZONE CREATED BY ARTICLE VI:  
“RESTRICTED PARKING.”**

The adoption of Ordinance No. 554, on May 12, 2016, created the following new section to Ordinance No. 525, which became Article VI: “Restricted Parking:”

There shall be no parking between 3:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. on the either side of the following streets:

1. Third Street from Mechanic Street to East Alley;
2. Wood Street between Third Street and First Street;
3. Second Street from Mechanic Street to Beazel Street, and
4. Green Street between Second Street and Third Street.

This instant Ordinance shall amend Ordinance No. 554 and shall further amend Ordinance No. 525, as subsequently modified by Ordinance No. 554, to remove Item No. 4 above, as follows:

Article VI: “Restricted Parking:”

There shall be no parking between 3:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. on the either side of the following streets:

1. Third Street from Mechanic Street to East Alley;
2. Wood Street between Third Street and First Street, and
3. Second Street from Mechanic Street to Beazel Street.

Accordingly, parking on either side of Green Street between Second Street and Third Street will now be permitted between 3:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m.

**SECTION 2. REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCES.**

Any and all prior Ordinances and/or any and all portions of prior Ordinances, including, specifically, Ordinance No. 525 and Ordinance No. 554, which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict. The remaining Ordinances and/or portions of prior Ordinances, not modified herein, shall remain the same.

**SECTION 3. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**

Should any section, provision or other part of this Ordinance be found to be illegal, unenforceable or void, such shall not affect the remainder hereof, which shall remain fully binding, valid and enforceable, and such section, provision or other part shall be modified to the extent necessary to so conform to the law.

The Borough Council of the Borough of California hereby declares its intention that should any section, provision or other part of this Ordinance be found to be illegal, unenforceable or void, it would have made the foregoing Ordinance without such part or with such part so modified so as to conform to the law.

**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.
